

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-18

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A WATER TAP FEE

Be it ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hillsboro, State of Ohio, that

SECTION ONE:

City Code Section 53.101 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

53.101. WATER TAP FEE.

(A) All water customers shall pay a one-time charge the time of first connection to the city of Hillsboro water system, as follows:

- 1" connection \$1,800 plus the actual cost of the radio read meter and meter pit \$ 165.00 pit
- 1.5" connection \$2,500 plus the actual cost of the radio read meter and meter pit \$ 280.00 pit
- 2" connection \$3,200 plus the actual cost of the radio read meter and meter pit \$ 280.00 pit
- 3" connection \$4,500 plus the actual cost of the radio read meter and meter pit \$ 280.00 pit
- 4" connection \$9,000 plus radio read meter, contractor builds pit
- 6" connection \$15,000 plus radio read meter, contractor builds pit
- 8" connection or larger \$30,000 plus radio read meter, contractor builds pit

(B) Where new developments are built, all water mains in said development are to be minimum 6 inches diameter and looped to existing mains.

(C) Multiple residence developments, consisting of two or more dwelling units, shall pay a minimum access fee to the water system equal to the number of dwelling units times the one-inch tap fee in subdivision (A), above.

SECTION TWO:

This ORDINANCE shall become effective upon passage by a majority of the members of Council, approval by the Mayor, and following 30-days after publication according to law.
