

**CITY OF HILLSBORO, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-17**

**AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE SALARY OF THE CITY AUDITOR AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Council for the City of Hillsboro desires to increase the salary of the City Auditor as recommended by the finance committee,

**WHEREAS**, Council has not raised the salary of the City Auditor since 2008, and as result of the increase in the cost of living believes an increased salary is appropriate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The salary of the City Auditor shall be \$57,500.00 per annum, payable in equal installments in periods determined by the City from time to time, effective at the commencement of the next pay period following passage of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, and Council has dispensed of three necessary readings and is essential to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hillsboro, Ohio to immediately allow the City Auditor to receive appropriate pay, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
