

**CITY OF HILLSBORO, OHIO
RESOLUTION NO. 23-32**

**A RESOLUTION TO SOLICIT BIDS AND ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR
PAVING A PORTION OF EAST BEECH STREET, WILLOW STREET, EAST AND WEST
COLLINS AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Public Works Superintendent, Council deems it necessary to solicit bids for paving the 100 block of East Beech Street, 100 block of Willow Street, and East and West Collins Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Council, deems it in the best interest of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Hillsboro that City to accept the lowest and best bid for paving the 100 block of East Beech Street, 100 block of Willow Street, and East and West Collins Avenue, not to exceed \$100,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Public Works Superintendent is hereby authorized to advertise for bids to resurface portions of East Beech Street, Willow Street, and East and West Collins Ave, and subsequently, accept the lowest and best bid not to exceed \$100,000.00.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, and Council has dispensed of three necessary readings and is essential to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hillsboro, Ohio to immediately address paving services for the City, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
