A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND ACCEPT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program is a flexible program that provides communities with resources to address a wide range of unique community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro has been awarded CDBG funds in the amount of \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Hillsboro believes accepting the CDBG funds is in the best interest of the City of Hillsboro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION ONE: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept and allocate CDBG funds not to exceed \$85,000.00.

SECTION TWO: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council, concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the City of Hillsboro, and more particularly, due to time constraints dictated by the terms of the agreement to accept funds and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
