CITY OF HILLSBORO, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 25-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY AND SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SOLICIT BIDS AND ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR DEMOLITION OF CERTAIN PARCELS WITHIN THE CITY OF HILLSBORO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Public Works Superintendent, Council deems it necessary to demolish permanent parcel numbers 25-25-001-048.00, 25-25-001-049.00, 25-25-001-050.00, 25-25-001-051.00, 25-25-001-052.00, 25-25-001-053.00 (formerly known as the Gross-Feibel Safe Company property), for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hillsboro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Safety and Service Director is hereby authorized to solicit bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder to complete the demolition of permanent parcel numbers 25-25-001-048.00, 25-25-001-049.00, 25-25-001-050.00, 25-25-001-051.00, 25-25-001-052.00, 25-25-001-053.00.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, and Council has dispensed of three necessary readings and is essential to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hillsboro, Ohio, to immediately abate a public nuisance, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
