The City of Hillsboro is excited to announce that Amazon is investing in a new delivery station in the city. The facility will be located at 1122 N West Street. Activity on-site will begin very soon, and we look forward to entering the next stages of construction as this exciting project progresses.

“This delivery station will allow us to better serve customers in Hillsboro and the surrounding area,” said Kyle DeGiulio, senior manager of economic development for Amazon. “We’re grateful for our partnership with the City of Hillsboro and we look forward to sharing more details about this facility in the future.”

The new delivery station will help power the last mile of Amazon’s fulfillment process by enabling fast, everyday delivery directly to customers’ doorstep.
