ORDINANCE NO. 2025-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32.086 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend certain sections of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro pertaining to the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that an amendment to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro to be in the best interests of the City of Hillsboro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:


SECTION 1: That the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro, more specifically Section 32.086, shall be amended as follows:


~~(Reserved)~~ Pursuant to R.C. 713.05, the Planning Commission shall appoint a clerk to assist the Planning Commission in the performance of its functions. The expenditures for such service and employment shall be paid by the City Council in the amount of \$100.00 per meeting.


SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, and Council has dispensed of three necessary readings and is essential to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Hillsboro, Ohio, to immediately compensate the Planning Commission Clerk, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
