ORDINANCE NO. 2025-29

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE SUPPLIER FOR THE CITY OF HILLSBORO
ELECTRIC AGGREGATION PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 4928 of the Ohio Revised Code, to facilitate competitive retail electricity service to promote electricity savings, lower cost of electricity supplies, and other benefits, certain governmental entities may aggregate certain electricity consumers within their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the electors of the City of Hillsboro have previously approved the City's plan to create an aggregation program for customers located within the boundaries of the City of Hillsboro during the election that occurred in May, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby selects and use Dynegy Energy Services (East), LLC D/B/A Dynegy Energy Services, LLC, during the term of this Agreement, as the exclusive provider of retail electric supply to the members of the Electric Aggregation Program for the implementation and administration of the City's municipal electric aggregation program in accordance with Revised Code 4928.20.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare of the City of Hillsboro and its residents such that the City must meet certain time frames involving the aggregation program and satisfying said time frames will result in promoting efforts to provide cost savings to residents of the City of Hillsboro.
