**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY AND SERVICE DIRECTOR TO
APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN
THE 2026 COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro seeks to participate in the 2026 Community Clean-Up Grant Program, a financial assistance program for solid waste, recycling and litter management purposes, administered by RPHF Solid Waste District.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Safety and Service Director is authorized to apply for, accept and enter into an agreement to participate in the 2026 Community Clean-Up Grant Program.


SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: By $\frac{3}{4}$ vote of its members, Council dispenses of three readings pertaining to this Resolution, pursuant to R.C. 731.17, and this Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law to allow for the application to be submitted by the deadline of March 1, 2026.
