A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER \$100,000 FUNDS FROM CONTINGENCY TO BLIGHTED PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.14, Transfer of funds, provides in part:

No transfer shall be made from one fund of a subdivision to any other fund, by order of the court or otherwise, except as follows: *** (E) Money may be transferred from the general fund to any other fund of the subdivision. *** Except in the case of transfer pursuant to division (E) of this section, transfers authorized by this section shall only be made by resolution of the taxing authority passed with the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members.

Be it RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hillsboro, State of Ohio, that

SECTION ONE:

Council authorizes and directs the auditor to transfer \$100,000 from the General Fund item 101.790.599990 CONTINGENCY to General Fund item 101.790.523730 BLIGHTED PROPERTY.

SECTION TWO:

This RESOLUTION shall become effective upon passage by a majority of Council, approval by the mayor.
