
DISCUSSION: Charlie Guarino, Chair of Imagine Hillsboro Master Plan explained to forum participants that the Master Plan was in the final stage and would be presented to Council on April 13, 2020. There will be an informational meeting prior to Council at 6:30 pm, consultants from McBride Dale& Clarion will be there to present the final draft and answer any questions. Mr. Guarino explained the recent changes to the Master Plan were the color- coded areas on pages 8 & 9 that detail short, mid, and long term stages of the work plan. Tom Eichinger- Council President asked if there was a critical path set forth for the work plan. Mr. Guarino answered that he had spoke to Emily Crowe, Consultant last week and she said the Critical path would be determined by the city, Council, Planning Commission. It should be a living document, evolving continually. Ann Morris asked if there were any plans for the unincorporated areas- islands. Chair of Planning Commission Rob Holt advised that the plan is to get them annexed, discussion was that it was a work in progress and areas would be targeted and once annexation would be completed for that area, a new area would be targeted. There were no questions from participants.
