SECTION ONE:


The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to disburse scholarship awards as follows:

Understand that all scholarship money is "INITIALLY" reported as the taxable income it is for which the City must furnish a 1099-MISC. Recipients must fill out a IRS Form W-4 in order to allow the City to prepare a 1099-MISC. Its taxability is offset by the "qualified" education expenses it is used to pay. Any scholarship monies not used for qualified expenses is taxable income to the recipient.
