RESOLUTION NO. 20-13

ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, OHIO 2019 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan is a long-range policy guide to decisions about the physical development of the city, addressing land use, transportation, community character, economic development, public facilities, utilities, housing, and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan gives long-range and comprehensive context and support for capital improvement projects, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) infrastructure and community improvement grants, as well as other state and federal grants and loans the city may apply for; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro desired a clear vision and direction based on changes in the community, city priorities, and policy direction; and

WHEREAS, the appointed steering committee has completed the research and drafting of a Imagine Hillsboro, 2019 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's Planning Commission recommended approval of Imagine Hillsboro, 2019 Comprehensive Plan to the City Council for adoption, at its April 13, 2020 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to adopt the 2019 Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hillsboro, at least a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council does hereby adopt the 2019 Comprehensive Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall cause a copy of the Comprehensive Plan to be deposited with the County Recorder.


Section 3. That the Council is acting in its administrative capacity in adopting this Resolution.


