RESOLUTION NO. 22-31

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HILLSBORO TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT RESIDENTIAL PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT, FOR FY22, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Development Residential Public Infrastructure Grant program helps local governments build, maintain, improve, and expand water and sanitary sewer systems in low- and moderate-income communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro desires financial assistance under the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH 2/3 OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION ONE: That the Safety Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application for Ohio Department of Development Community Development Block Grant Funding from the Community Development Program and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION TWO: The FY22 Residential Public Infrastructure Grant award is for up to \$750,000 for primarily residential infrastructure improvements.

SECTION THREE: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION FOUR: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the City of Hillsboro, and more particularly, for the reason that it is necessary to take immediate action to secure funds, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
