

**CITY OF HILLSBORO, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2024-38**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 100.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF HILLSBORO PERTAINING TO THE REGULATIONS FOR CITY PARKS**

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the City of Hillsboro Parks Director, Council desires to amend certain sections of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro, pertaining to the regulations for city parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro, more specifically section 100.01 of the City Code, shall be amended as follows:

§ 100.01 REGULATIONS FOR CITY PARKS.

(A) A code of standard regulations is hereby enacted at the Hillsboro City Parks to read as follows.

- (1) The fishing pond is a recreational facility per ODNR rules.
- (2) The maximum catch for released fish is unlimited.
- (3) The maximum catch is per ODNR rules.
- (4) Regular park hours are dawn to dusk.
- (5) No alcoholic beverages.
- (6) No driving on the grass.
- (7) No boats.
- (8) No littering.
- (9) No driving in excess of park speed limits.
- (10) Use of tobacco products shall be prohibited, including but not limited to, any device or delivery system sold in combination with nicotine which can be used to deliver to a person nicotine in aerosolized or vaporized form.
- (11) Pets are strictly prohibited in any area where signs indicating such prohibition are posted.
- (12) No illicit drugs.
- (13) Use of marijuana products shall be prohibited.


(B) Any person in violation of these regulations, in addition to any other penalty provided by law, shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$100, and shall be subject to a one-year expulsion from the city parks upon three or more offenses within two years.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
